

THUNDEREGG *A Very Fine Sample of What's Available at the Mine CD*

It was the fall of 1993 when Thunderegg first plugged in. Twelve years and 259 songs later, here's the debut album, *A Very Fine Sample of What's Available at the Mine*.

On *A Very Fine Sample*, Thunderegg—singer/guitarist Will Georgantas, bassist Jake Fournier, and drummer Keith Woodfin—hammer out ten fan favorites with crucial help from engineer/guitarist Nathan Gohla and a roster of guests including Jonathan Chatfield (keyboards), Tim Kane (trumpet), and Tom Colligan (guitar). Smart, melodic, accessible, warm: Thunderegg's beloved if almost entirely unknown sound is the product of long friendships, devotion to the music for its own sake, and the unique ambience of the Shed, Gohla's tiny studio in Manchester, Connecticut. Call-outs this time around include "In the Loft," "Keep It with You," and "If I Went on a Diet," which was selected by *Jane* magazine for its 2002 *Reader-Produced CD*.

As for the 259 songs that led up to the release of *A Very Fine Sample*, those were recorded by Will to his four-track in any of the twelve different bedrooms that he occupied between 1995 and 2004. Released as eight separate CDs over the years, they will be compiled on this winter's single-CD mp3 anthology *Open Book*, nine hours of newly mastered music featuring bonus tracks, fan appreciations, and a deluxe lyric booklet.

Thunderegg is back in the Shed working with Nate on a follow-up full-band CD. And to round things out, Will is writing, recording, and posting a new song every week to Thunderegg's web site at www.thunderegg.org. These new tracks will be compiled for still another release in early 2006.
